I, FRANK M. JORDAN, Secretary of State of the State of California, hereby certify:

That on the 22nd day of July, 1952, pursuant to the provisions of the County Water District Law, more particularly Section 30321 of the Water Code, there was filed in my office the Certificate of the County Clerk of the County of Yuba stating that a proposition for the formation of the Yuba County Water District had been submitted to and approved by the voters in the area of the proposed district at an election held on the 24th day of June, 1952 -- such proposition being: "Shall the proposition to form Yuba County Water District Law be adopted?"

I further certify that said Certificate reads in part, as follows: "And I do further certify that by order of said board of supervisors of the county of Yuba duly and regularly made and entered this 30th day of June, 1952, at the conclusion of the canvass of the said special election, it was declared that the formation of said Yuba County Water District was approved by the voters, and the said Yuba County Water District was thereby declared to be formed."

I further certify that by reason of the statements set forth in said Certificate, and its filing in my office, that certain territory situated in the County of Yuba, State of California, of which the boundaries are described in said Certificate, is hereby duly incorporated according to the laws of this State under the name:
